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Attacks of Sleep and Weakness in Dogs.

Narcolepsy and Cataplexy are disorders of the nervous system.

Narcolepsy occurs when an animal suffers from excessive daytime sleepiness, lack of energy, or brief losses of consciousness. These disorders are relatively common in dogs. Narcolepsy is a rare condition characterized by excessive sleepiness and brief attacks of cataplexy or muscle weakness. In humans, it affects about 0.05% of the population.

Narcolepsy is a neurological disorder that causes persistent sleepiness and additional symptoms such as brief episodes of muscle weakness known as **cataplexy**, vivid, dreamlike hallucinations, brief episodes of paralysis when falling asleep or upon awakening (sleep paralysis), and fragmented nighttime sleep. The **nervous system** is the principal target for a number of metals. Inorganic compounds of **aluminum, arsenic, lead, lithium, manganese, mercury, and thallium** are well known for their neurological and behavioral effects in humans and pets.

The alkyl derivatives of certain metals-lead, mercury and tin-are specially neurotoxic.

Cataplectic attacks often occur in response to a stimulus that generates excitement, such as food or toys. The dog usually passes through three stages with measurable changes in their brains: the first stage is characterized by paralyzed muscles but waking EEG in the brain and normal visual tracking; in the second the brain reaches a sleeping state similar to REM, while in the third, normal EEG returns before the dog wakes up. Narcolepsy is caused by lower than normal levels of a neuropeptide called orexin (or sometimes hypocretin) in the brain. The episodes do not cause any harm, but allopathic medicines can offer no cure and dogs will have this condition throughout their lives. However, much improvement to resolving if we use herbs and homeopathics.

Ways To Combat Your Dog's Exposure To Heavy Metals:

WHERE DOES THESE TOXINS COME FROM?

Food

Heavy metals are in our foods and they are dangerously high in the bones many of our dogs eat for dinner. Calcium supplements for humans are no longer derived from bone since heavy metal contamination was discovered in bones.

As early as 2009, veterinarian Richard Pitcairn DVM PhD had concerns for the heavy metals sequestered in the long bones of our food animals that grazed in fields alongside highways where cars fuelled by leaded gasoline traveled.

He points to studies showing a link to the country's use of petroleum products. High levels of heavy metals generally relate to environmental pollution. Bone tissues appear to be a long-term bio-indicator of environmental exposure to heavy metals like lead, cadmium and mercury.

Field studies show the high levels of heavy metals in the environment may be monitored by their concentration in target organs and tissues of free-roaming mammals.

The late Gloria Dodd DVM, a pioneering holistic veterinarian, wrote *Chronic Heavy Metal Poisoning – Silent Killer in Pets* describing tests she'd done that uncovered high levels of aluminum, mercury, lead and cadmium in many of her patients, as well as in her own cat, whose toxicity she traced back to commercial cat food.

Besides naming all the pet foods that contained high levels of the herbicide, he discusses the addition of sodium nitrite to foods as a preservative; in the presence of glyphosate, sodium nitrite is deadly and a carcinogen.

Corn, soy, sugar beets, cotton, canola, all genetically modified, use the glyphosate as a desiccant prior to harvesting. Wheat barley and sorghum are sprayed with glyphosate. These foods are not only fed to our dogs, they are fed to the food animals all of us eat!

MIT researcher Dr Stephani Seneff has authored *The Destructive Effects of Heavy Metals and Glyphosate*. Glyphosate, it turns out, is a major driver of disease.

This toxin stays in bones – our bones – but also in the bones of the food-producing animals where our “raw meaty bones” are obtained to feed our dogs. My colleague the late Dr Gloria Dodd evaluated the presence of metals in pet foods and aluminum is one of the metals found in high levels.

Dr Seneff talks about **the aluminum** accumulation in the brain and the synergistic promotion by glyphosate. Not only do heavy metals sequester in bones, but so does the glyphosate and this is a staggeringly toxic combination. Mercury and aluminum are all the more toxic in the context of glyphosate.

Vaccines become much more toxic because glyphosate inhibits detoxification organs from eliminating these chemical toxins. Animals are being inoculated with vaccines that contain heavy metals. They have a cumulative effect over generations and that is a lot of heavy metal damage to retrieve from the body and the genome of a species.

Here's a comment from one of the pet food manufacturers Dr Dodd confronted about the high levels of aluminum in his foods: "...he said he knew he had aluminum contamination in his pet food when it was producing Alzheimer-like symptoms in his four-year-old test dogs."

Dr Dodd posed the rhetorical question, "Why didn't he pull his pet food off the market when he knew he had a problem?"

Dr Dodd tested many other brands of pet food, which all contained various levels of aluminum, mercury, cadmium and lead. She was especially interested in aluminum because it was in all the foods tested, and at a much higher level than the other heavy metals. While aluminum is a mineral, it acts like a heavy metal, both chemically and physiologically. Aluminum levels in the kibbles she tested were much higher than canned wet foods because the dehydration of the product concentrates the substances in the food. Aluminum is in the air, water and soil and it's taken up by the vegetables, fruits and grains we grow. Food-producing livestock take aluminum into their tissues through their own food sources. Aluminum concentrates as it goes up the food chain ... and of course, we and our dogs are at the very top of this food chain.

Sources Of Mercury Poisoning

Pet Vaccines

Mercury is a toxic heavy metal with no known safe dose.

Aluminum is a light metal that acts like a heavy metal; both are **neurotoxic**, (e.g. *neurotoxins are toxins that are poisonous or destructive to nerve tissue. Neurotoxins are an extensive class of exogenous chemical neurological insults that can adversely affect function in both developing and mature nervous tissue*) Sad to say, the damage from heavy metals is pretty much ubiquitous. Although animals are safe from dental implants, they are being inoculated repeatedly with **vaccines that contain heavy metals**.

Signs and Symptoms As an example of the scope of a heavy metal's toxicity, lead can affect the nervous system, gastrointestinal system, cardiovascular system, blood production, kidneys, and reproductive system. Symptoms of heavy metal toxicity include mental confusion, pain in muscles and joints, headaches, short-term memory loss, gastrointestinal upsets, food intolerances/allergies, vision problems, chronic fatigue, and others. The symptoms are so vague that it is difficult to diagnose based on symptoms alone.

- **Aluminium.** is the most common adjuvant in veterinary vaccines. ...
- **Thimerosal.** This **mercury** based additive has been used as a preservative for decades and apparently the extreme neurotoxicity that **mercury** in general and Thimerosal in particular have also been known for decades. ...

Aluminum Toxicity in Brains

Aluminum present in medicines, cosmetics, and food could be slowly poisoning our brains. There are numerous side effects and signs that are strongly linked to aluminum toxicity in the brain. Some of the notable ones include the following:

- Feelings of irritability
- Feeling of agitation or annoyance
- Uneasiness or feelings of apprehension.
- Aversion to odors, movement, touch, and noise
- Abnormal sensitivity to both cold and hot temperatures
- Heightened sensitivity to darkness and light
- Breathing disorders
- Urinary and bowel dysfunction
- Sleep disorders
- The exhibition of Parkinsonian symptoms
- Dysfunction of organs such as the thyroid gland and kidney
- Muscle weakness
- Involuntary muscle twitches



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- Immune dysfunction
- Imbalance
- Ear disorders that may be characterized by hearing loss
- Eye disorders
- Extreme exhaustion or fatigue
- Cardiac complications such as congestive heart failure

Mercury - Mercury toxicity has been linked to, among other things, mercury dental fillings, particularly when people have a large number of them. Symptoms include a metallic taste in the mouth, excess salivation, gingivitis, tremors, stomach and kidney troubles. Mental symptoms include shyness, irritability, apathy and depression, psychosis, mental deterioration, and anorexia.

Formaldehyde - *The toxic effects of formaldehyde in experimental animals include irritation, cytotoxicity, and cell proliferation in the upper respiratory tract, ocular irritation, pulmonary hyperactivity, bronchoconstriction, gastrointestinal irritation, and skin sensitization.*

Other reported effects include oxidative stress, neurotoxicity, neurobehavioral effects, immunotoxicity, testicular toxicity, and decreased liver, thyroid gland, and testis weights (IARC 2006, Asian et al. 2006, Sarsilmaz et al. 2007, Gopalipour et al. 2008, Ozen et al. 2005, Majumder and kumar 1995).

A Drug from your Vet will be offered to suppress the brain activity to some degree but not cure.

Amitriptyline HCl 10mg drug

The Amitriptyline drug is a tricyclic [antidepressant](#). Amitriptyline affects chemicals in the brain that may be unbalanced in people with depression. This drug to a certain degree helps control some of the brain activity, but it does not heal or restore the nervous system damages.

Get emergency medical help if you have **signs of an allergic reaction to amitriptyline**: hives; difficulty breathing; swelling of your face, lips, tongue, or throat. Report any new or worsening symptoms to your Vet, such as: *mood or behavior changes, anxiety, panic attacks, trouble sleeping, or if you feel impulsive, irritable, agitated, hostile, aggressive, restless, hyperactive (mentally or physically), more depressed, or hurting themselves.*

Call your vet at once if your pet has:

- unusual thoughts or behavior;
- a light-headed feeling, like you might pass out;
- chest pain or pressure, pain spreading to your jaw or shoulder, nausea, sweating;
- pounding heartbeats or fluttering in your chest;
- confusion, hallucinations;
- a seizure (convulsions);
- painful or difficult urination;
- severe constipation;
- easy bruising, unusual bleeding; or
- sudden weakness or ill feeling, fever, chills, sore throat, mouth sores, red or swollen gums, trouble swallowing.

Common amitriptyline side effects may include:

- constipation, diarrhea;
- nausea, vomiting, upset stomach;
- mouth pain, unusual taste, black tongue;
- appetite or weight changes;
- urinating less than usual;
- itching or rash;

The episodes do not cause any harm, and using this but allopathic medicines like Amitriptyline HCl can offer no cure and dogs will have this condition throughout their lives. However, much improvement to resolving if we use herbs and homeopathics. This will only suppress or control some of the symptoms or lessen the episodes, but it does not fix or cure the dog or human of this condition.
